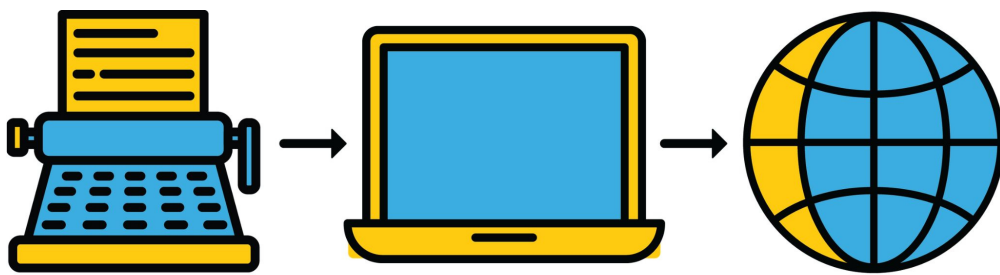

The resulting report will include a comprehensive list of elements that require adjustment in order to meet the standard. To ensure the most accurate results, we use a range of tools for testing, both Windows and Mac-based, as well as mobile devices like the iPhone, Android, iPad and tablets. We then test using a number of Assistive Technology Tools such as Braille readers, Non-Visual Digital Access (NVDA) and Job Access With Speech (JAWS), We also conduct compatibility tests with a number of different search engines including Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, Internet Explorer, and Safari.

The report not only identifies areas that need improvement, but also provides practical solutions for resolving the issues. Our goal is to help make your website more accessible to a wider range of users, and ensure that it meets the standards for compliance in today's digital landscape.

Training

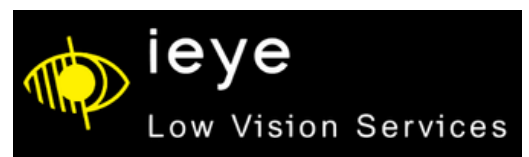
